

Rhosneigr lights up -6th December

This year we are going to light up the high street by having 25 illuminated Christmas trees on the business premises and village hall. Brackets to hold the trees have been put up by Project Rhosneigr together with Brett from **Carina**, (to whom we pass on our thanks). Donations have been obtained from the **businesses** themselves, **Menter Môn, Community Council, John Morrison** and **Energy Solutions**. There will be a "switching on" ceremony on Saturday



6th December at 6.00pm, with free mulled wine, mince pies and nibbles in **Sullivan's** provided by **Menaï Cottages and Sullivan's**. Our local councillor and leader of Anglesey Council **Phil Fowlie** will be officiating and there will be a couple of carols for you to join in with. We hope this event will be a big hit and a lot of effort is being put into creating a more "Christmassy" spirit for the village.

Maelog Lake



We have been able to improve the area at the start of the boardwalk with special thanks to **John Ward** from Surf Point (who levelled off the area and provided the sand base) and **Bryan Horan** from the Minstrel Lodge development (who provided the slate chippings). All other work was carried out by Project Rhosneigr. A special thanks also to those people who donated plants – we will start planting up the area in the spring but would still welcome any more plants that you can donate for this area.

Improvement of boatpool outlook

We have been trying for a long time to improve the area, known as boatpool outlook. For various reasons this has not been possible but now working with the Community Council who have registered the land for the community we are able to once again apply for grants to enhance this area which looks so badly neglected. We would



like to provide a nice landscaped area with seating, face the concrete front with stone to be more in keeping with the area, and cover the drainage channel which protrudes from the sand. We would welcome any suggestions that you may have which could be incorporated in this scheme.

Breaking News

The Community Council with assistance from our County Councillor **Phil Fowlie** have arranged for the County Council to do a sweep of stone debris etc on the beach by the old Bay Hotel complex, which will return this part of the beach back into a state that we can all hopefully be proud of.



War Memorials

Within our community we have two public war memorials, which were built by public subscription. The more visible and known memorial is the clock in Rhosneigr dedicated to the fallen in the First and Second World Wars and second is a memorial in the cemetery beside the chapel in Bryn Du



dedicated to the fallen in the First World War. Both memorials are in need of repair / refurbishment with the more significant financial expenditure on the Rhosneigr memorial, where the ingress of water through the roof requires major work.

The Community Council has direct responsibility for the clock and believes it has a duty of care on behalf of the community for the memorial in Bryn Du. It is currently exploring grants available to undertake the work and has also opened an appeal for funds.
